## Information about this Operator's Manual

Read this Operator's Manual carefully in order to make yourself familiar with the safe and correct operation, maintenance and transport of the tractor. This avoids injuries and damage to the tractor. If you cannot understand parts of this Operator's Manual, contact your CLAAS Sales Partner.

This Operator's Manual is part of the tractor and must be handed over to the buyer of the tractor in case of resale. If the Operator's Manual and/or safety decals applied to the tractor are lost or damaged, these items can be reordered from a CLAAS Sales Partner. This Operator's Manual is also available in other languages.

Directions such as front, rear, right and left apply in the direction of travel.

## Intended use

The CLAAS tractor / implement carrier / the agricultural tractor is intended for professional use according to the recognized rule of agricultural practice for agricultural work exclusively.

The tractor is suitable and intended for pulling, pushing and carrying implements / forage boxes / loads approved by the manufacturer on fields and on public roads, for actuating certain implements and for compacting goods by means of implements (weights) approved by the manufacturer, depending on the regulations of the road vehicle regulations in force.

The tractor may be used, serviced and repaired only by persons who are familiar with its handling and who have been instructed about the function-related hazards.

Compliance with the conditions of operation, maintenance and servicing as specified in the operator's manual and by the manufacturer also constitute essential elements for the intended use.

The relevant accident prevention regulations as well as the other recognised safety-related, industrial medicine and road traffic law rules must be respected both by the user and the owner.

Any use beyond the above scope shall be deemed as being <contrary to the intended use>. The manufacturer accepts no liability for damage resulting from this. All liability is borne by the user.

For specific details, you may request information on intended use in exceptional situations from CLAAS.

## Reasonably foreseeable misuse

Use outside of the intended use represents a use not provided for by the manufacturer and therefore represents a misuse. The manufacturer accepts no liability for damage resulting from this. All liability is borne by the user.

Such misuse of the tractor includes:

- Use of areas or spaces that are not described as workplaces, maintenance areas or access areas in the Operator's Manual
- Performing adjustments, cleaning and maintenance work contrary as specified in the Operator's Manual
- Performing troubleshooting and repairs while drives and/or the diesel engine are running
- Failure to observe warnings on the tractor and in the Operator's Manual
- Performing maintenance and repair work by persons not trained for such work
- Performing unauthorized modifications on the tractor
- Installing non-approved additional equipment
- Use of spare parts not meeting CLAAS requirements
- Use as a carrier vehicle for implements / forage boxes not approved by the manufacturer
- Use for compacting goods or grounds by means of devices / implements (manure tanks, seeds containers, implements which shift the point of gravity considerably to the top or to the side)
- Use for participating in sports events
- Exceeding of the permitted technical total weight or of the technically permitted axle load
- Transporting of persons

## Hazard signs



This hazard sign warns of risks of injury.

- ▶ To avoid injuries and death, follow all measures marked by this hazard sign.

## Signal word

The warnings in this Operator's Manual are introduced by the hazard sign and a signal word. The signal word expresses the extent of the hazard.

### **DANGER!**

DANGER identifies a dangerous situation that leads to death or serious injury if not avoided.

### **WARNING!**

WARNING identifies a dangerous situation that may lead to death or serious injury if not avoided.

---

### **CAUTION!**

CAUTION identifies a dangerous situation that may lead to slight injuries if not avoided.

---

## **Transferring the tractor to a third party**

The tractor which is the subject of this manual complies with the regulations in force in the destination country on the date on which it was originally released onto the market by the manufacturer, via its official network of dealerships or importers. If subsequently exported or imported, always check that the tractor complies with the regulations in force in the destination country.

Always pass the details of the new owner on to the nearest dealership, so that they can be notified of any modification or improvement campaigns.

If the tractor is sold or transferred, always ensure that the operator's manual is provide with it so that it is available for the new owner to consult. If the tractor is transferred without the manual, the new owner may encounter dangerous situations due to a lack of knowledge regarding the tractor and the safety rules.

## Importance of the Operator's Manual

The Operator's Manual is an important document and a part of the tractor. It addresses the user and contains safety-relevant information. Only the procedures specified in the Operator's Manual are safe.

- ▶ Read the chapter on safety before using the tractor for the first time and observe it at all times.
- ▶ Before starting work, read and observe the respective sections of the Operator's Manual.
- ▶ If you cannot understand the content or require help, contact your CLAAS sales partner.

## Observing safety decals and warnings

Safety decals on the tractor and warnings in the Operator's Manual warn of hazards at dangerous points and are an important part of the tractor's safety equipment. Missing or unidentifiable safety decals increase the risk of serious and fatal injuries of persons.

- ▶ Before putting the tractor into operation, read and observe the safety precautions and warnings in the Operator's Manual and the safety decals on the tractor.
- ▶ Clean soiled safety decals.
- ▶ Replace any missing and unidentifiable safety decals immediately.

- ▶ Apply the relevant safety decals to spare parts.  
Warning symbols
- ▶ Spare parts and components supplied by sub-suppliers may contain additional safety precautions not mentioned in this Operator's Manual.

## Requirements made on all persons working with the tractor

To avoid accidents, every person working with the tractor must meet the following minimum requirements:

- The person is physically capable of controlling the tractor.
- It is healthy and does not suffer from tiredness.
- It is not under the influence of drugs.
- It is able to carry out the work described in this Operator's Manual in accordance with safety regulations.
- The person understands how the tractor operates and is able to identify and avoid hazards involved with the work.
- The person understands and is able to apply the information provided in the Operator's Manual.
- The person is familiar with driving vehicles in a safe manner.
- As far as road travel is concerned, the person knows the relevant road traffic rules and has the legally required driver's licence.
