

With net sales of 21.243 billion Lire in 1983 and 243,000 employees the Fiat Group was ranked by Fortune magazine in 1982 as the biggest company in Europe and the eighth-largest (excluding the oil companies) in the world. The Fiat Group operates in 18 countries through 210 direct, joint-venture and licensed production plants.

Fiat Auto is Europe's number one car producer, with a 12.8% share of the total market.

Iveco, wholly owned by the Fiat Group, is Europe's second-largest commercial vehicle manufacturer, and third in the world for diesel engine production.

Directly or through its 650 associated or subsidiary companies, the Fiat Group is also active in the fields of original equipment manufacturing, earth-moving equipment, manufacturing systems, civil engineering, rolling stock, telecommunications, bio-medicine, jet-engines, gas turbines, tourism and transport.

In 1983 alone, the Fiat Group invested 550 billion Lire equal to 2.6% of turnover, in research and development.

The Fiat Group's activities in support of agriculture are all handled by Fiatagri, which is Fiat's third largest division, after cars and commercial vehicles.


At the San Matteo (Modena) spares centre, a highly modern installation with 21,600 square metres under roof and equipped with electronic
