Fiat Group operates in 18 countries through 170 direct, joint-venture and licensed production plants.

Fiat Auto is Europe's top selling car producer (except in Spain), with a 13.3% share of the total market.

Iveco, wholly owned by Fiat Group, is Europe's second-largest commercial vehicle manufacturer, and third in the world for diesel engine production.

Directly or through its 650 associated or subsidiary companies, Fiat Group is also active in the fields of original equipment manufacturing, earth-moving equipment, manufacturing systems, civil engineering, rolling stock, telecommunications, bio-medicine, jet engines, gas turbines, tourism and transport.

In 1984 alone, Fiat Group invested 661 billion Lire which, combined with some 1500 billion Lire of fixed capital investment, amounts to 9.5% of turnover, in research and development.

Fiat Group's activities in support of agriculture are all handled by Fiatagri, which is Fiat's third largest division, after cars and commercial vehicles.

Thanks to the French base, European customers can have the same high quality as American buyers without being penalized by unfavourable exchange rates or heavy shipping costs.

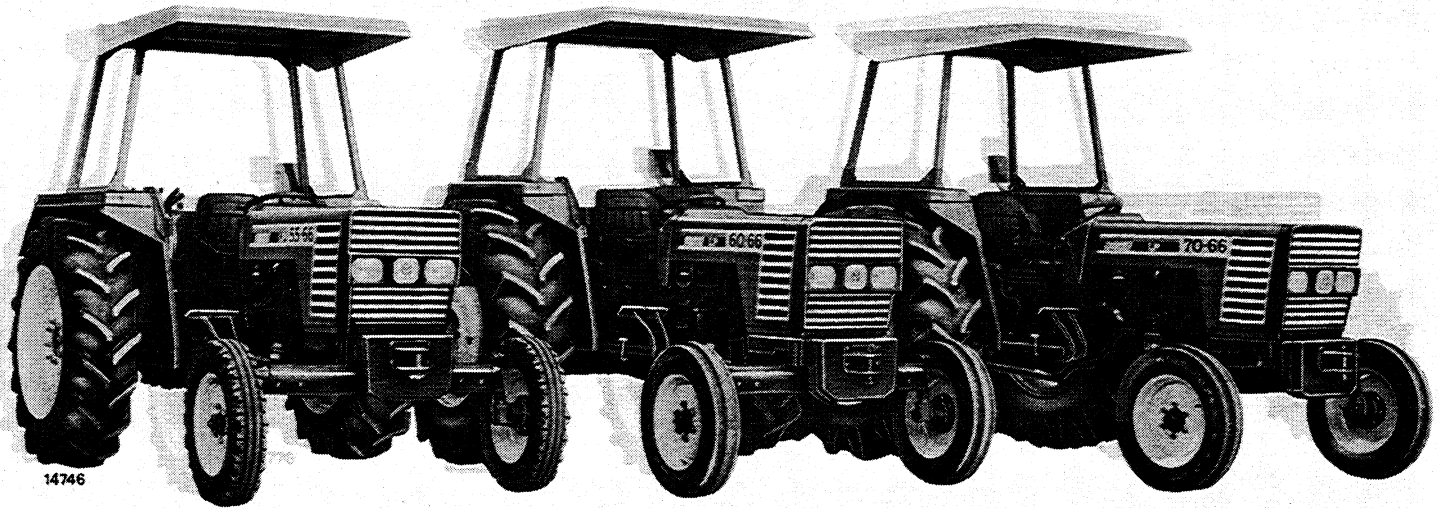
