## SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Most farm equipment accidents can be avoided by following simple safety precautions. These precautions, if followed at all times, will help you operate your dozer safely.

- Do not attempt to start the tractor engine while standing beside the tractor. Always start the engine while sitting in the tractor operator's seat.
- Always stop the engine when leaving the tractor.
- Do not leave the tractor-dozer when it is in motion.
- Do not allow anyone but the operator to ride on the tractor-dozer.
- Do not make mechanical adjustments while the unit is in motion, the blade is raised, or the engine is running.


- 6. Do not tow the tractor faster than 20 mph.
- Do not attempt to repair or tighten hydraulic hoses when under pressure, when the tractor engine is running, or when the blade is raised.
- 8. Do not dismount from the tractor and leave the dozer blade raised.
- Do not get under the blade when the dozer blade is raised.
- When parking, make sure the parking brakes are set and the dozer blade is fully lowered.
- Place adequate counterweight on the rear of the tractor and move wheels to recommended settings for optimum stability.
- Exercise extreme caution when operating the tractor with the dozer blade on the sides of a hill.

## Serial No. Plate
