OPERATING THE BLADE

- Use extra caution when back filling deep holes or trenches.
- Make adjustments only when blade is attached to tractor.
- When removing, changing angle, or adjusting blade, be sure that your feet are not under blade.
- Keep all people and pets a safe distance away when operating blade.
- Avoid excessive tractor speed during operation.
- Use care when ditching on slopes to prevent overturning.
- Never allow anyone to ride on blade.
- Read your tractor operator's manual carefully for information on its safe use.
- Do not modify or alter or permit anyone to modify or alter this blade or its components.


SET-UP AND ASSEMBLY

The blade is shipped in one carton containing blade, rear frame, front frame, lift link assembly and hardware bag.

Remove all contents from carton.

HARDWARE BAG CONTENTS

Empty the hardware bag and use the illustration to sort and compare quantities. Also included in the hardware bag but not illustrated here are (1) hitch pin, (1) spring, and (1) stabilizer.
