



GENERAL PREPARATION

- 1. Read this manual carefully to acquaint yourself with the equipment as well as the tractor operator's manual. Working with unfamiliar equipment can lead to accidents. Be thoroughly familiar with the controls and proper use of the equipment. Know how to stop the unit and disengage the controls quickly.
- Keep hands, feet, and clothing away from power driven parts.
- 3. Prolonged exposure to loud noise can cause impairment or loss of hearing. Wear a suitable hearing protective device such as earmuffs or earplugs to Protect against objectionable or uncomfortable noises.
- 4. Reduce noise level (lower RPM) when working near hospitals or in the vicinity of people, etc.
- 5. Eye protection must be worn at all times.
- 6. Always use a dust mask when working in dusty conditions.
- 7. Keep safety decals clean of dirt and grime.
- 8. Be sure the PTO is in OFF position before starting the engine.
