

Thank you for purchasing a New Holland product.



Whenever you contact your Authorized Service Dealer or the factory, always know the model and serial numbers of your product. These numbers will help the Service Dealer or Service Representative provide exact information about your specific product. You will find the model and serial number plate located in a unique place on the product as shown below.

Read this manual, and all related equipment manuals, carefully to learn how to operate and maintain your product correctly. Reading this manual will help you and others avoid personal injury and damage to the product. Although we design, produce and market safe, state-of-the-art products, you are responsible for using the product properly and safely. You are also responsible for training persons, who you allow to use the product, about safe operation.

The warning system in this manual identifies potential hazards and has special safety messages that help you and others avoid personal injury, even death. DANGER, WARNING and CAUTION are signal words used to identify the level of hazard. However, regardless of the hazard, be extremely careful.

**DANGER** signals an extreme hazard that will cause serious injury or death if the recommended precautions are not followed.

WARNING signals a hazard that may cause serious injury or death if the recommended precautions are not followed.

CAUTION signals a hazard that may cause minor or moderate injury if the recommended precautions are not followed.

Two other words are also used to highlight information. "Important" calls attention to special mechanical information and "Note" emphasizes general information worthy of special attention.

The left and right side of the machine is determined by sitting on the seat in the normal operator's position.

#### **Safety and Instruction Decals**



Safety decals and instructions are easily visible to the operator and are located near any area of potential danger. Replace any decal that is damaged or lost.

ON UPPER DISCHARGE CHUTE (Part No. TR94D8079)



- **CONTACT WITH MOVING PARTS** INSIDE CHUTE WILL CAUSE
- SHUT OFF ENGINE BEFORE UN-CLOGGING DISCHARGE CHUTE. **NEVER PUT HAND IN CHUTE.**

A rear-mount quick attach hitch and rear wheel weights and chains, all of which must be purchased separately, are required to operate the tractor equipped with this snowthrower. Use the chart below to identify parts used for assembly.
