

The warning system in this manual identifies potential hazards and has special safety messages that help you and others avoid personal injury, even death. *Danger*, *Warning*, and *Caution* are signal words used to identify the level of hazard. Danger signals an extreme hazard that will cause serious injury or death if the recommended precautions are not followed.

Warning signals a hazard that may cause serious injury or death if the recommended precautions are not followed.

Caution signals a hazard that may cause minor or moderate injury if the recommended precautions are not followed.

Two other words are also used to highlight information. *Important* calls attention to special mechanical information, and *Note* emphasizes general information worthy of special attention.


Safety decals and instructions are easily visible to the operator and are located near any area of potential danger. Replace any decal that is damaged or lost.

Preliminary Preparation

- 1. Park the tractor and mower on a level surface, disengage the PTO, set the parking brake, stop the engine, and remove the ignition key.
- 2. Remove the spark plug wire(s) from the spark plug(s).
- 3. Lower the mower to its lowest position and remove the mower from the tractor. Refer to the Mower Operator's Manual for removal instructions.

4. Thoroughly clean the mower. All debris must be removed to ensure that parts will fit the mower properly.
