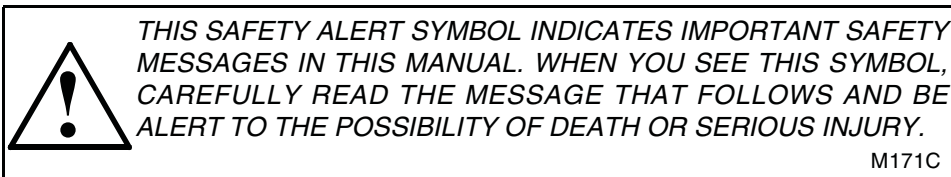

# OPERATOR'S MANUAL

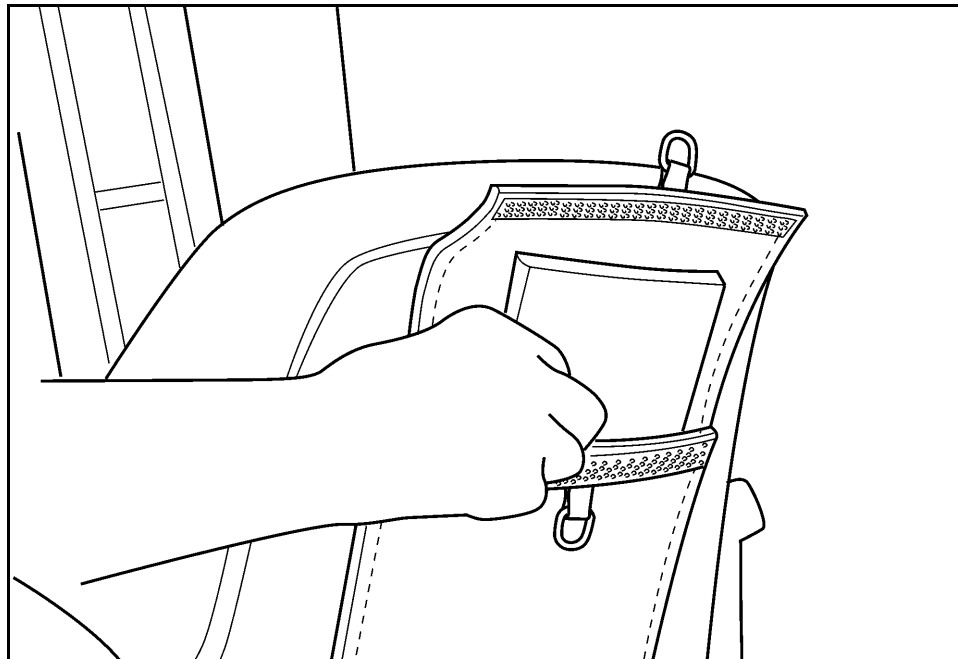

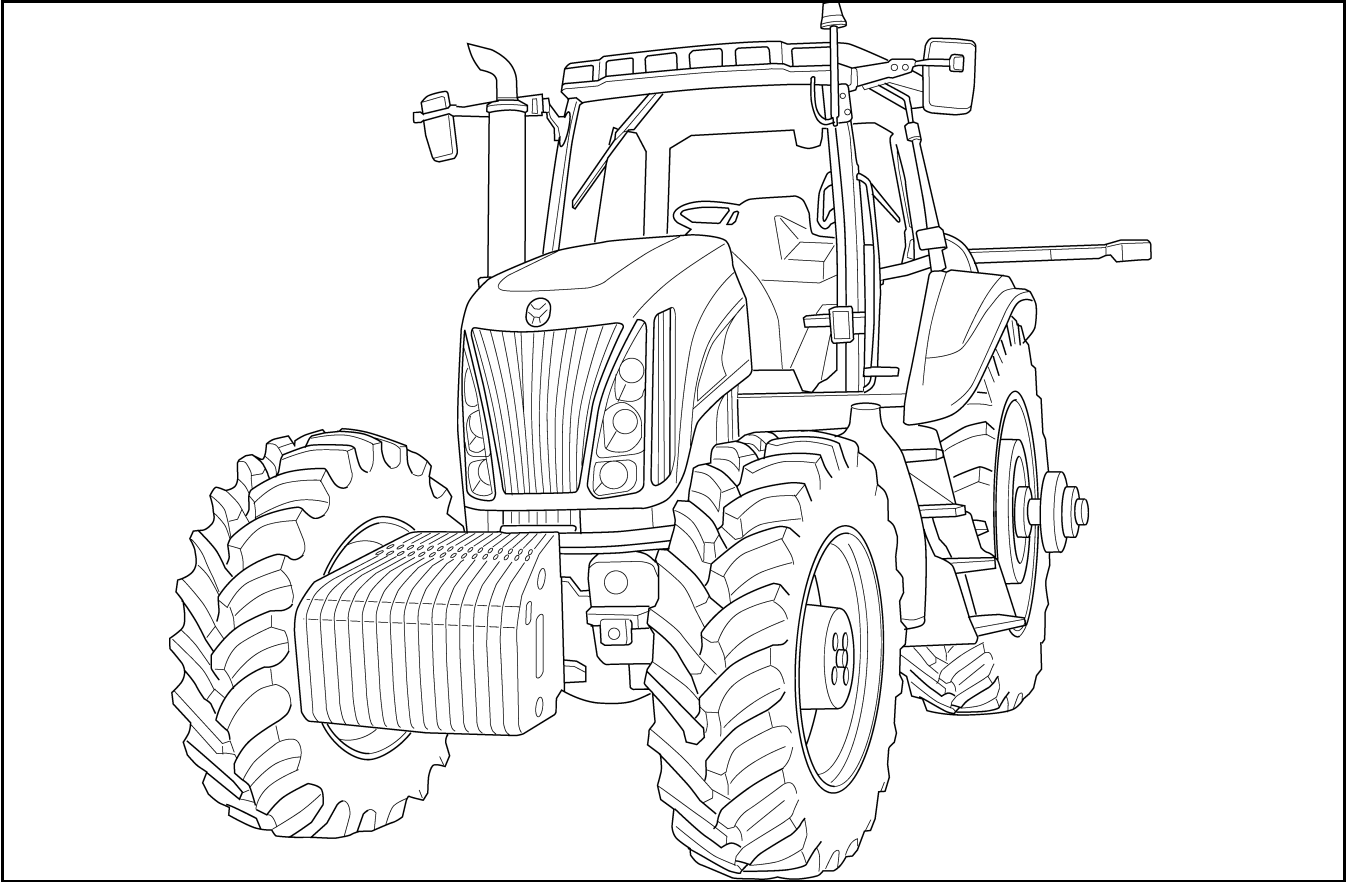
