Safety Rules


The safety information given in this manual does not replace safety codes, federal, state and local laws. Make sure your loader has the correct equipment needed by the local laws and regulations.

Operation

WARNING Before starting tractor engine, study Operator's Manual safety messages.

CAUTION If tractor is ROPS equipped, do not exceed the manufacturers rating for maximum gross vehicle weight. Refer to Tractor Operator's Manual, ROPS Section.



CAUTION Do not lift or carry personnel on an attachment, a slip or fall could cause bodily injury.



CAUTION If the tractor is equipped with a Rollover-Protective Structure (ROPS), fasten seat belt prior to starting engine.
