Removal Procedure

Start By:

- A. Remove the water temperature regulator. Refer to Disassembly and Assembly, "Water Temperature Regulator Remove and Install".
- B. Remove the exhaust manifold. Refer to Disassembly and Assembly, "Exhaust Manifold Remove and Install".
- C. Remove the valve mechanism cover base. Refer to Disassembly and Assembly, "Valve Mechanism Cover Base Remove and Install".
- D. Remove the electronic unit injectors. Refer to Disassembly and Assembly, "Electronic Unit Injector Remove".
- E. Remove the camshaft gear. Refer to Disassembly and Assembly, "Camshaft Gear Remove and Install".



NOTICE

Do not turn the crankshaft or the camshaft while the camshaft gear is removed. If the front gear group is not correctly timed during installation, interference can occur between the pistons and the valves, resulting in damage to the engine.

1. Remove bolts (2) and thrust plate (1).

2. Remove seal assembly (3) and adapter (4).



3. Remove O-ring seals (5) and (6) from seal assembly (3) .



4. Disconnect hose assembly (7) from cylinder head (8).



Note: If the engine is not equipped with an air compressor, skip Step 5.

- 5. Disconnect hose assemblies (11) and hose assemblies (12) from the air compressor.
- 6. Remove the bolt and clamp (9) from the hose assembly. Remove hose assembly (10).



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- 7. Remove the bolt and support clip (13) for the harness assembly.
- 8. Disconnect the harness assembly from sensor (14), sensor (15), and ground stud (16).

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
