


Figure 1. Number 10 Mower - Manual Lift.




Figure 2. Number 10 Mower - Hydraulic Lift.

INTRODUCTION

The CASE Number 10 Semi-Mounted Mower is designed for quiet, smooth running and clean mowing for extended periods with a minimum of upkeep. The heavy duty frame and anti-friction bearings together with cushioned "V" belt drive are designed to withstand as well as minimize the vibration inherent in a Mower.

Both the inner and outer shoes float independently of the lift controls, whether manual or hydraulic. The inner shoe can pass over a bump or drop in a depression, while the outer shoe continues to follow the contour of the ground – even on banks where the outer shoe may be higher or lower than the tractor wheels.

Long coil spring and gag lever mechanism is easily adjustable to provide positive floating action at all times.

Pressure lubrication is provided at the points of maximum speed or maximum movement.

A safety break-back feature protects the cutter bar against breakage should it strike an obstruction. The knife continues to operate - thus clearing the bar and it is only necessary to back the tractor to automatically latch the cutter bar back in its proper operating position.

Complete and simple adjustments are provided to assure the best possible mowing job under all conditions.

The Number 10 Mower is easily and quickly attached to CASE as well as most other makes of tractors making it possible for the owner to utilize the mower on two different types of tractors, if desired.

Extra equipment for this mower includes a wide variety of cutter bars, knives and guards, a high cutting attachment and windrowers.
