## INTRODUCTION

The CASE Number 103 Front End Loader has been designed with a view to long life, ease in operation and facility in mounting and dismounting.

Booms are heavily constructed and rigidly braced to counteract the various stresses inherent in a Front End Loader. Truss angles return bucket to center even when working Front End Loader at an angle.

Bucket control is simple yet positive. Bucket automatically resets into loading position when lowering and the loaded bucket is easily dumped by convenient trip lever located near the tractor seat.

The bucket can be dumped from any height up to the maximum lift of approximately eight feet. Bucket is cushioned by spring stops when dumped.

Bucket has replaceable runner shoes to prevent unnecessary wear on the bucket. Times are secured to bucket with one bolt which acts as a shear pin and eliminates damage to loader when driving into a solid obstruction.

Rapid acting hydraulic rams provide ample lift and speed a loading or light dirt moving operation.

An outstanding feature of the CASE Number 103 Series? Front End Loader is the ease with which they can be mounted or dismounted - making it possible for the tractor operator alone to complete this task.




Figure 2. Number 103 Series Front End Loader
