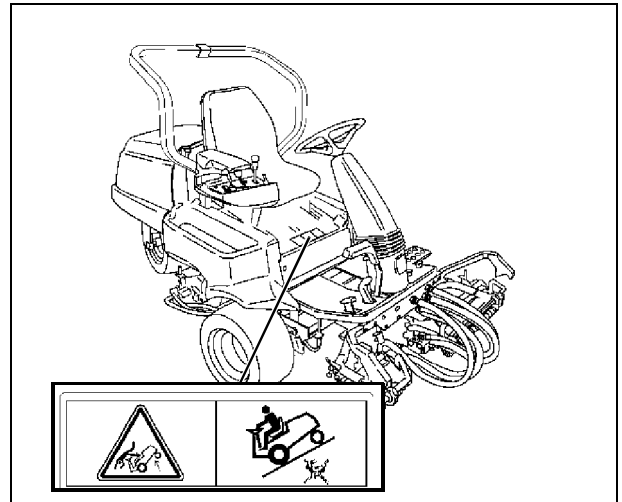
Pictorial Safety Signs



Safety-Alert Symbol

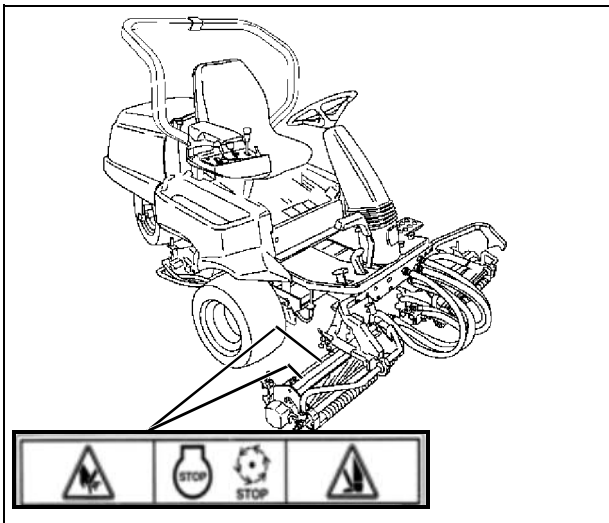

DANGER



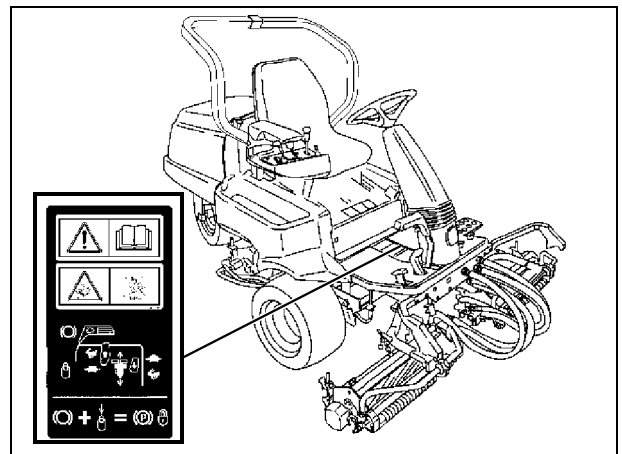
