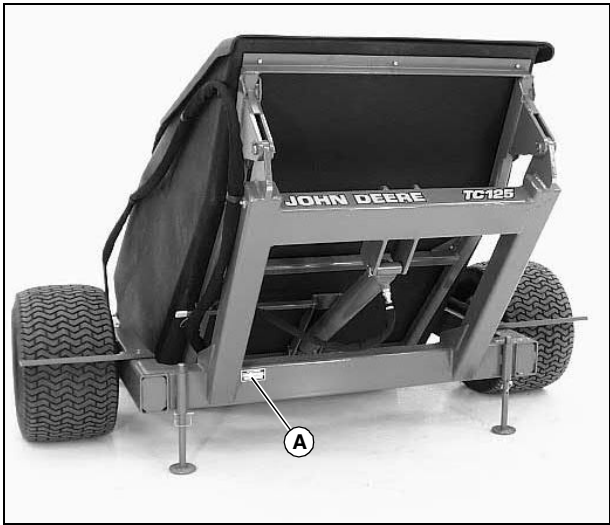

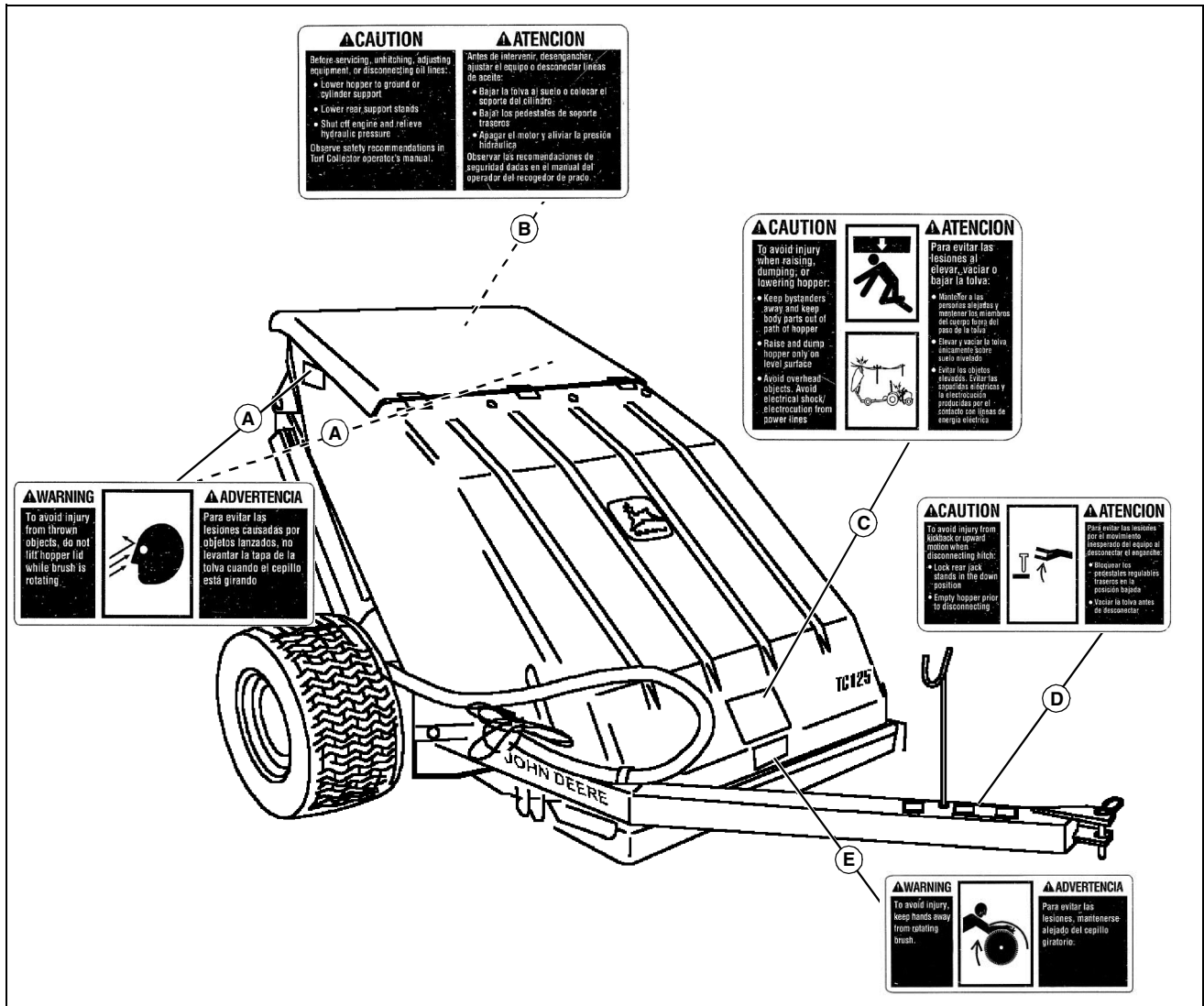

Understanding The Machine Safety Labels

The machine safety labels shown in this section are placed in important areas on your machine to draw attention to potential safety hazards.

On your machine safety labels, the words DANGER, WARNING, and CAUTION are used with this safety-alert symbol. DANGER identifies the most serious hazards.

The operator's manual also explains any potential safety hazards whenever necessary in special safety messages that are identified with the word, CAUTION, and the safety-alert symbol.

There can be additional safety information contained on parts and components sourced from suppliers that is not reproduced in this operator's manual.

To avoid injury from thrown objects, do not lift hopper lid while brush is rotating.

Before servicing, unhitching, adjusting equipment, or disconnecting oil lines:

- Lower hopper to ground or cylinder support.
- Lower rear support stands.
- Shut off engine and relieve hydraulic pressure.

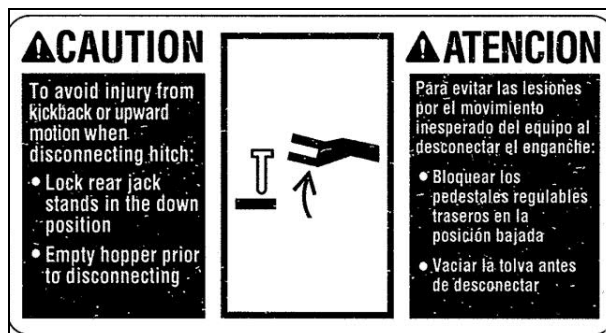

To avoid injury when raising, dumping, or lowering hopper:

- Keep bystanders away and keep body parts out of path of hopper.
- Raise and dump hopper only on level surface.
- Avoid overhead objects. Avoid electrical shock/electrocution from power lines.

To avoid injury from kickback or upward motion when disconnecting hitch:

- Lock rear jack stands in the down position.
- Empty hopper prior to disconnecting.

To avoid injury, keep hands away from rotating brush.
