

INTRODUCTION

This manual is intended to illustrate in a general way the assembly and adjustment of the implements being made available for use on the Models "VA" and "VAC" Tractors with Case Eagle Hitch.

A separate manual, RI-162, is provided to cover care and operation instructions of the Hydraulic System and Case Eagle Hitch on Models "VAC", "VA", and "VAH" tractors.

"Right" and "Left" are designated when standing at the rear of the tractor and facing the direction of travel.

Rear wheel tread of the model VAC Tractor with Case Hitch can be adjusted from 48" to 88" to accommodate the mounted implements designed for various row spacings. Wheel settings for individual implements will be specified in various paragraphs in this manual.




FIGURE 1 ONE-BOTTOM PLOW

Standard equipment for the one-bottom plow consists of a long landside bottom, coulter, pull bar bundle, and beam and mast bundle. The two-bottom plow bundles include bottoms, coulters, pull bar bundle, beam and mast bundle, and a rear furrow wheel. Optional sizes and types of coulters and bottoms are available.

A rear furrow wheel is available as extra equipment for the one-bottom plow. Coulter jointers are available as extra equipment for either the one or two-bottom plow.
