Start By:

a. Remove the axle housing.

NOTICE

Keep all parts clean from contaminants.

Contaminants may cause rapid wear and shortened component life.



1. Remove plates (1), brake discs (2), and brake hub (4) from the brake cylinder assembly. Remove dowels (3).



Personal injury can result from being struck by parts propelled by a released spring force.

Make sure to wear all necessary protective equipment.

Follow the recommended procedure and use all recommended tooling to release the spring force.

2. Remove bolts (10), washers (9), bushing (8), and spacer (7). Remove bolts (16), retainers (15), springs (14), springs (13), and bushings (12), as an assembly. Use a suitable pry bar and remove brake piston (6) from brake cylinder assembly (11). Remove O-ring seals (5) from brake piston (6). Repeat this step for the opposite side.



3. Remove bolts (17) from brake cylinder assembly (11).



Note: Before you remove brake cylinder assembly (11), make location marks for installation purposes.

- 4. Remove brake cylinder assembly (11).
- 5. Repeat Step 3 and Step 4 for the opposite side.
- 6. Remove the differential and bevel gear assembly (18) from the bevel gear side of the center housing.



7. Remove bolt (20) and retainer (19). Use Tooling (A) to remove spanner nut (22). If necessary, remove bearing cup (21) from brake cylinder assembly (11). Repeat this step for the opposite side.

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
