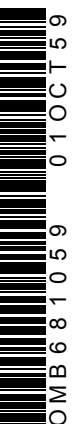

Study this manual carefully. Keep it handy, in a safe place, for future reference.



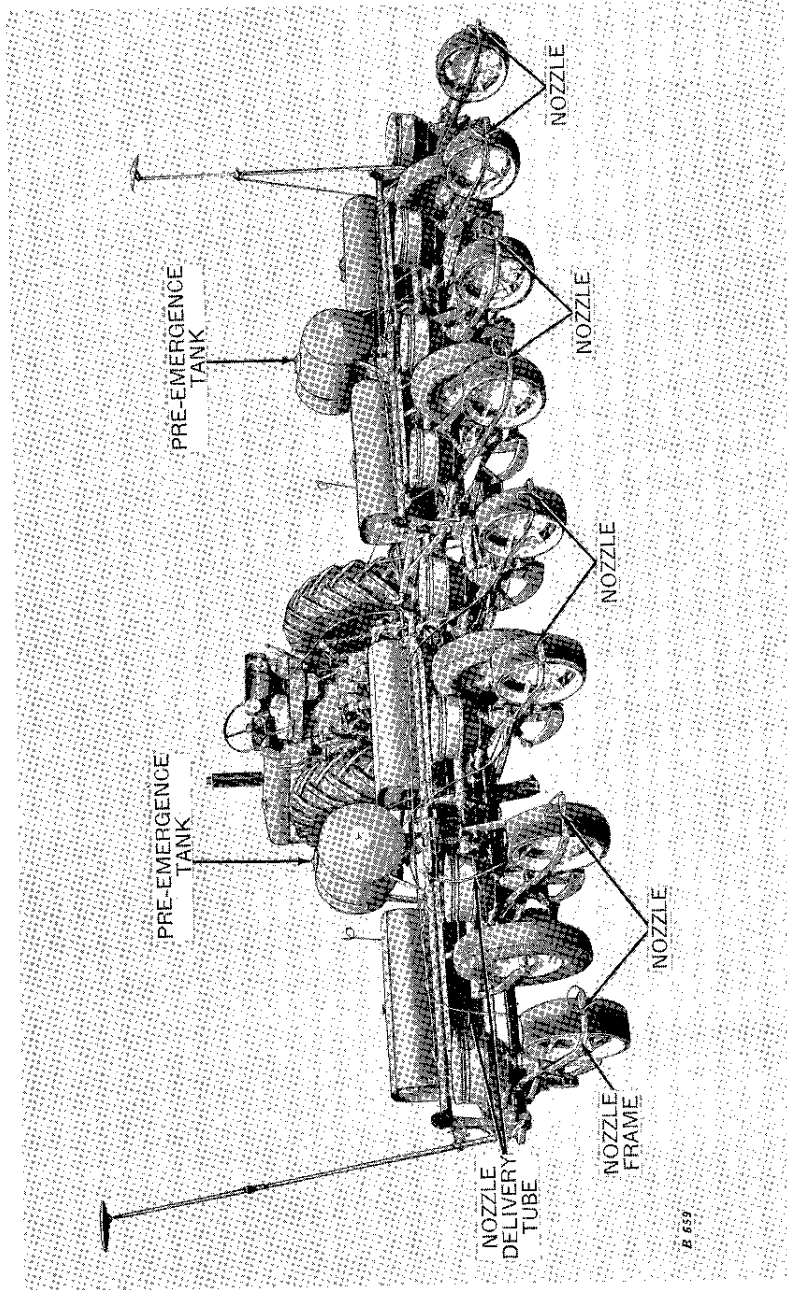
Right-hand and left-hand reference is determined by standing at the rear of the machine and facing the direction of travel.

Pre-Emergence Sprayer for Two 494 Corn Planters

SPECIFICATIONS

The Pre-Emergence Sprayer is used to apply any commercial liquid form of herbicide in the row at the time of planting. It can be used with or without the liquid or dry fertilizer attachment. All parts are made from a chemical resistant material.

TANK CAPACITY—Approximately 36 gallons (4-row)—approximately 54 gallons (6-row).

PUMP—A gear pump operated by the tractor power take-off furnishes the pressure needed to operate the sprayer.

CONTROLS—The pressure regulator is easily accessible and the pressure gauge is visible from the tractor seat.

NOZZLES—Located at the rear of the press wheels.

NOZZLE TIPS—Nozzle tip number B11655B is furnished as regular equipment. Other nozzle tips of various sizes are available from your John Deere dealer.

WIDTH OF SPRAY BAND—Adjustable, by moving the nozzle frame up or down.
