
This safety alert symbol identifies important safety messages in this manual. When you see this symbol, be alert to the possibility of personal injury and carefully read the message that follows.

"Right-hand" and "left-hand" sides are determined by facing in the direction of mower-conditioner forward travel.

If your mower-conditioner requires replacement parts, go to your John Deere dealer where you can obtain Genuine John Deere parts - accept no substitutes.




