Introduction

THANK YOU for purchasing a John Deere product.

READ THIS MANUAL carefully to learn how to operate and service your vehicle correctly. Failure to do so could result in personal injury or equipment damage. This manual and safety signs on your machine may also be available in other languages. (See your John Deere dealer to order).

THIS MANUAL SHOULD BE CONSIDERED a permanent part of your vehicle and should remain with the vehicle when you sell it.

MEASUREMENTS in this manual are given in both metric and customary U.S. unit equivalents. Use only correct replacement parts and fasteners. Metric and inch fasteners may require a specific metric or inch wrench.

RIGHT-HAND AND LEFT-HAND sides are determined by facing in the direction of the machine or implement will travel when going forward.

WRITE PRODUCT IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS (P.I.N.) in the Specification or Identification Numbers section. Accurately record all the numbers to help in tracing the vehicle should it be stolen. Your dealer also needs these numbers when you order parts. File

the identification numbers in a secure place off the vehicle.

WARRANTY is provided as part of John Deere's support program for customers who operate and maintain their equipment as described in this manual. The warranty is explained on the warranty certificate which you should have received from your dealer.

This warranty provides you the assurance that John Deere will back its products where defects appear within the warranty period. In some circumstances, John Deere also provides field improvements, often without charge to the customer, even if the product is out of warranty. Should the equipment be abused, or modified to change its performance beyond the original factory specifications, the warranty will become void and field improvements may be denied. Setting fuel delivery above specifications or otherwise overpowering vehicles will result in such action.

TIRE WARRANTY - John Deere warranty applies for tires available through the John Deere parts system. For tires not available through the John Deere parts system, the tire manufacturer's warranty applicable to your vehicle may not apply outside the U.S. (See your John Deere dealer for specific information).

CLEANING AND POLISHING PLASTIC HOOD AND FENDERS

IMPORTANT: To keep scratches on plastic parts to minimum, do not rub or brush off any parts with bare hands, use a soft cloth (i.e. cheesecloth) or a light flow of compressed air. For dirt, wash with steady stream of water only (no detergent), then blow off excess water with air.

- 1. Remove excess dust or dirt.
- 2. When surface is dry, spray on PLEDGE® and leave-for 30 to 60 seconds.
- 3. Using a dry soft cloth (i.e. cheesecloth) wipe off to bring up lustre.



Keep your machine in proper working condition.



INSPECT UTILITY VEHICLE
