





Safety-Alert Symbol

Machine Safety Labels

WARNING: Hot Surface

One on each side (rear) of Front Mower.



DANGER: Rotating Blade

To avoid injury from rotating blades, stay clear of deck edge.





Machine Safety Labels (Continued)

DANGER: Rotating Blade

To avoid injury from rotating blades and thrown objects, stay clear of deck edge and keep others away.

Do not mow without discharge chute or entire grass catcher in place.



DANGER: Explosive Gases

Cigarettes, flames or sparks could cause battery to explode.

Always shield eyes and face from battery.

Do not charge or use booster cables or adjust post connections without proper instruction and training. Keep vent caps tight and level.

Poison: Causes Severe Burns

Contains sulfuric acid.

Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing.

In event of accident, flush with water and call a physician immediately.

Keep out of reach of children.
