# Introduction

READ THIS MANUAL carefully to learn how to operate and service your Material Collection System (MCS) correctly. Failure to do so could result in personal injury or equipment damage.

THIS MANUAL SHOULD BE CONSIDERED a permanent part of your MCS and should remain with the MCS when you sell it.

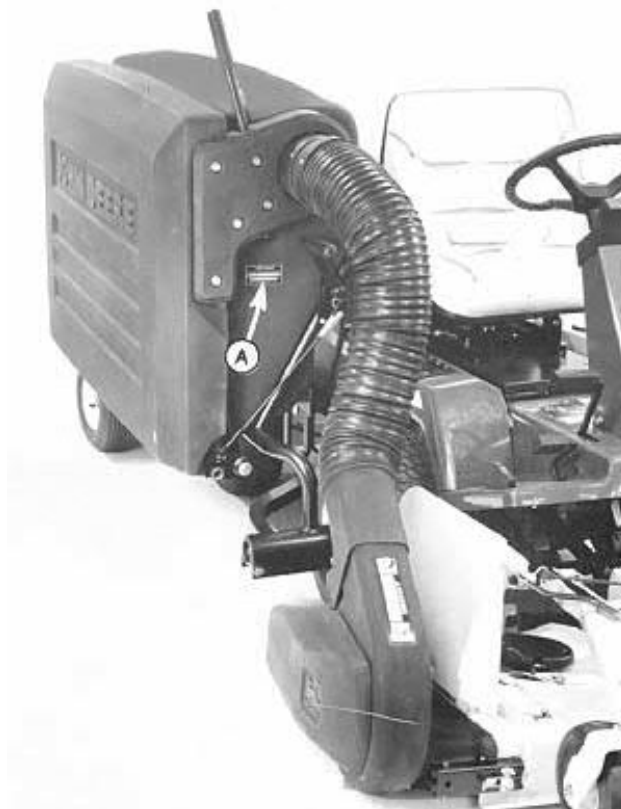
MEASUREMENTS in this manual are U.S. customary units and their metric equivalents.

RIGHT AND LEFT SIDES are determined by facing in the direction of forward travel.

WRITE MCS NUMBER: \_\_\_\_\_ See the picture below for location of the number (A). Accurately record the number to help trace the MCS if it is stolen. Your dealer also needs this number when you order parts. File the number in a safe place.

WARRANTY is provided as part of John Deere's support program for customers who operate and maintain their equipment as described in this manual. The warranty is explained on the warranty certificate which you should have received from your dealer.

This warranty provides you the assurance that John Deere will back its products where defects appear within the warranty period. In some circumstances, John Deere also provides field improvements, often without charge to the customer, even if the product is out of warranty. Should the equipment be abused, or modified to change its performance beyond the original factory specifications, the warranty will become void and field improvements may be denied. Setting fuel delivery above specifications or otherwise overpowering machines will result in such action.

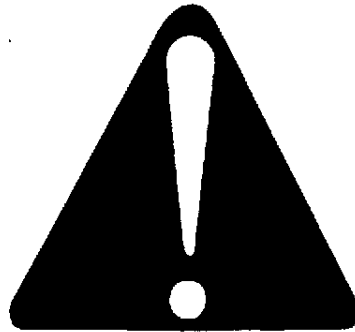

## FOLLOW SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

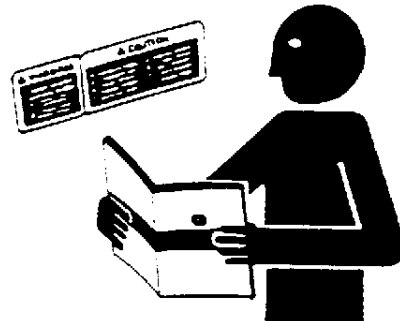
Carefully read all the safety messages in this manual and on your MCS safety sign. Keep the safety sign in good condition. Replace a missing or damaged safety sign.

## INSPECT THE MCS BEFORE YOU OPERATE IT

Do not operate the MCS unless all parts are in good condition and fastened in place.

Check for loose, badly worn, damaged, or missing parts.

The controls must operate freely.

## AVOID INJURY FROM THROWN OBJECTS

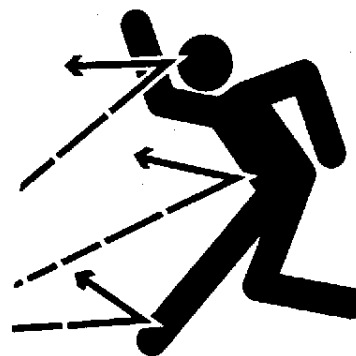
Clear the work area of objects that may be thrown.

—Push the PTO switch down to the OFF position to stop the mower and Power Flow™.
